^{10:1} By the _____ and _____ of Christ, I appeal to you—I, Paul, who am “_____” when face to face with you, but “bold” toward you when away! ² I _____ you that when I come I may not have to be as bold as I _____ to be toward some people who think that we live by the standards of this world. ³ For though we live in the world, we do not _____ as the world does. ⁴ The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have _____ power to demolish _____. ⁵ We demolish _____ and every _____ that _____ itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take _____ every thought to make it obedient to Christ. ⁶ And we will be ready to _____ every act of _____, once your obedience is complete.

⁷ You are _____ by _____. If anyone is confident that they belong to Christ, they should consider again that we belong to Christ just as much as they do. ⁸ So even if I boast _____ freely about the authority the Lord gave us for building you up rather than tearing you down, I will not be ashamed of it. ⁹ I do not want to seem to be trying to _____ you with my letters. ¹⁰ For some say, “His letters are _____ and _____, but in person he is _____ and his speaking _____ to nothing.” ¹¹ Such people should realize that what we are in our letters when we are absent, we will be in our actions when we are present.

¹² We do not dare to _____ or compare ourselves with some who commend themselves. When they _____ themselves by themselves and compare themselves with themselves, they are not wise. ¹³ We, however, will not boast beyond proper limits, but will _____ our boasting to the sphere of service God himself has assigned to us, a sphere that also _____ you. ¹⁴ We are not going too far in our boasting, as would be the case if we had not come to you, for we did get as far as you with the gospel of Christ. ¹⁵ Neither do we go beyond our limits by boasting of work done by others. Our hope is that, as your faith _____ to grow, our sphere of _____ among you will greatly _____, ¹⁶ so that we can preach the gospel in the regions beyond you. For we do not want to boast about work already done in someone _____. ¹⁷ But, “Let the one who boasts boast in the Lord.” ¹⁸ For it is not the one who commends himself who is _____, but the one whom the Lord commends.
