

## 2 Corinthians 6 Blanks

<sup>6:1</sup> As God's co-workers we urge you not to receive God's grace in vain. <sup>2</sup> For he says, "In the time of my favor I heard you, and in the day of salvation I \_\_\_\_\_ you." I tell you, now is the time of God's favor, now is the day of salvation.

Or what fellowship can light have with darkness? <sup>15</sup> What \_\_\_\_\_ is there between Christ and \_\_\_\_\_? Or what does a believer have in common with an unbeliever? <sup>16</sup> What \_\_\_\_\_ is there between the temple of God and idols? For we are the temple of the living God. As God has said: "I will live with them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be my people." <sup>17</sup> Therefore, "Come out from them and be separate, says the Lord. \_\_\_\_\_ no unclean thing, and I will receive you." <sup>18</sup> And, "I will be a Father to you, and you will be my sons and \_\_\_\_\_, says the Lord \_\_\_\_\_."
