We have wronged no one, we have _____ no one, we have _____ no one. ³ I do not say this to _____ you; I have said before that you have such a place in our hearts that we would live or die with you. ⁴ I have spoken to you with great _____; I take great pride in you. I am greatly encouraged; in all our troubles my joy knows no _____.

⁵ For when we came into Macedonia, we had no rest, but we were _____ at every turn—_____ on the outside, _____ within. ⁶ But God, who comforts the _____, comforted us by the coming of Titus, ⁷ and not only by his coming but also by the comfort you had given him. He told us about your longing for me, your deep sorrow, your concern for me, so that my joy was greater than _____.

⁸ Even if I caused you sorrow by my letter, I do not regret it. Though I did regret it—I see that my letter _____ you, but only for a little while—⁹ yet now I am happy, not because you were made _____, but because your sorrow led you to repentance. For you became sorrowful as God intended and so were not _____ in any way by us. ¹⁰ Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death. ¹¹ See what this godly sorrow has _____ in you: what earnestness, what eagerness to clear yourselves, what _____, what _____, what longing, what concern, what _____ to see _____ done. At every point you have proved yourselves to be innocent in this matter. ¹² So even though I wrote to you, it was neither on _____ of the one who did the wrong nor on _____ of the _____, but rather that before God you could see for yourselves how devoted to us you are.

¹³ By all this we are encouraged. In addition to our own _____, we were especially _____ to see how happy Titus was, because his spirit has been refreshed by all of you. ¹⁴ I had _____ to him about you, and you have not _____ me. But just as everything we said to you was true, so our boasting about you to Titus has proved to be true as well. ¹⁵ And his affection for you is all the greater when he _____ that you were all obedient, receiving him with fear and trembling. ¹⁶ I am glad I can have complete confidence in you.
