¹⁰ Now he who _____ seed to the _____ and bread for food will also supply and _____ your _____ of seed and will _____ the harvest of your righteousness. ¹¹ You will be enriched in every way so that you can be generous on every _____, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God.

¹² This service that you _____ is not only _____ the _____ of the Lord's people but is also overflowing in many _____ of thanks to God. ¹³ Because of the service by which you have proved yourselves, others will praise God for the obedience that _____ your _____ of the gospel of Christ, and for your generosity in sharing with them and with everyone else. ¹⁴ And in their prayers for you their hearts will go out to you, because of the surpassing grace God has given you. ¹⁵ Thanks be to God for his _____ gift!
